Inspired by the capital's historical monuments, the modern, bold, and powerful design included a custom white finish of Reynobond® ACM panels for longevity and a timeless appeal to closely resemble the nation's landmarks in the nearby area.

Using a pressure equalized rain-screen composite panel system, MG McGrath Inc. fabricated and installed over 6,750 square feet of Reynobond® ACM panels along the roof and soffit line in a high performing, coil coated Colorweld® 500 Kuala White finish backed by a 30-year warranty that will be sure to leave the casino and resort an area staple for years to come.
